The European Commission has published two reports based on the study "Cost-benefit analysis of FAIR research data", which was conducted for the Commission by PricewaterhouseCoopers. €10.2B is just the minimum cost per year of not having **FAIR** research data for the EU and it will rise further over the years if we do not take action

Based on a study performed for the **Eu Commission**, the guidance provided in them will ensure the sustainable financing of FAIR model implementation in the context of the European Open Science Cloud (**EOSC**).
