Assessing the FAIRness of your repository's data holdings can help you to identify areas where your service could be optimised to become more FAIR-enabling. This webinar will introduce the F-UJI assessment tool (<https://www.fairsfair.eu/f-uji-automated-fair-data-assessment-tool>) which was developed through the FAIRsFAIR project to support the programmatic assessment of seventeen minimum viable metrics for FAIR data objects. These metrics build upon those proposed by the RDA FAIR Data Maturity Model Working Group and others. During this webinar you'll learn about how to scope and carry out an assessment and hear about how the results can help you to identify areas of your current service provision where improvements may be needed.
