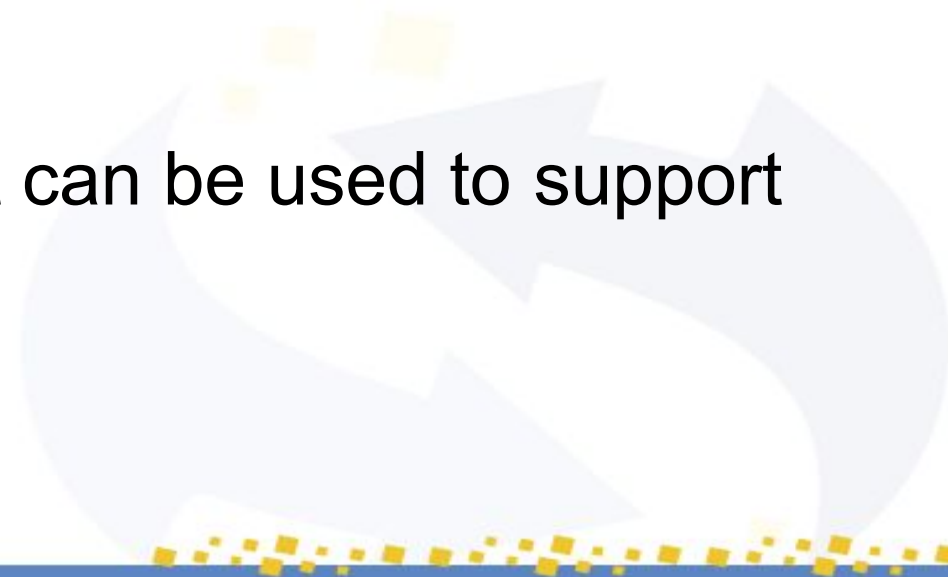

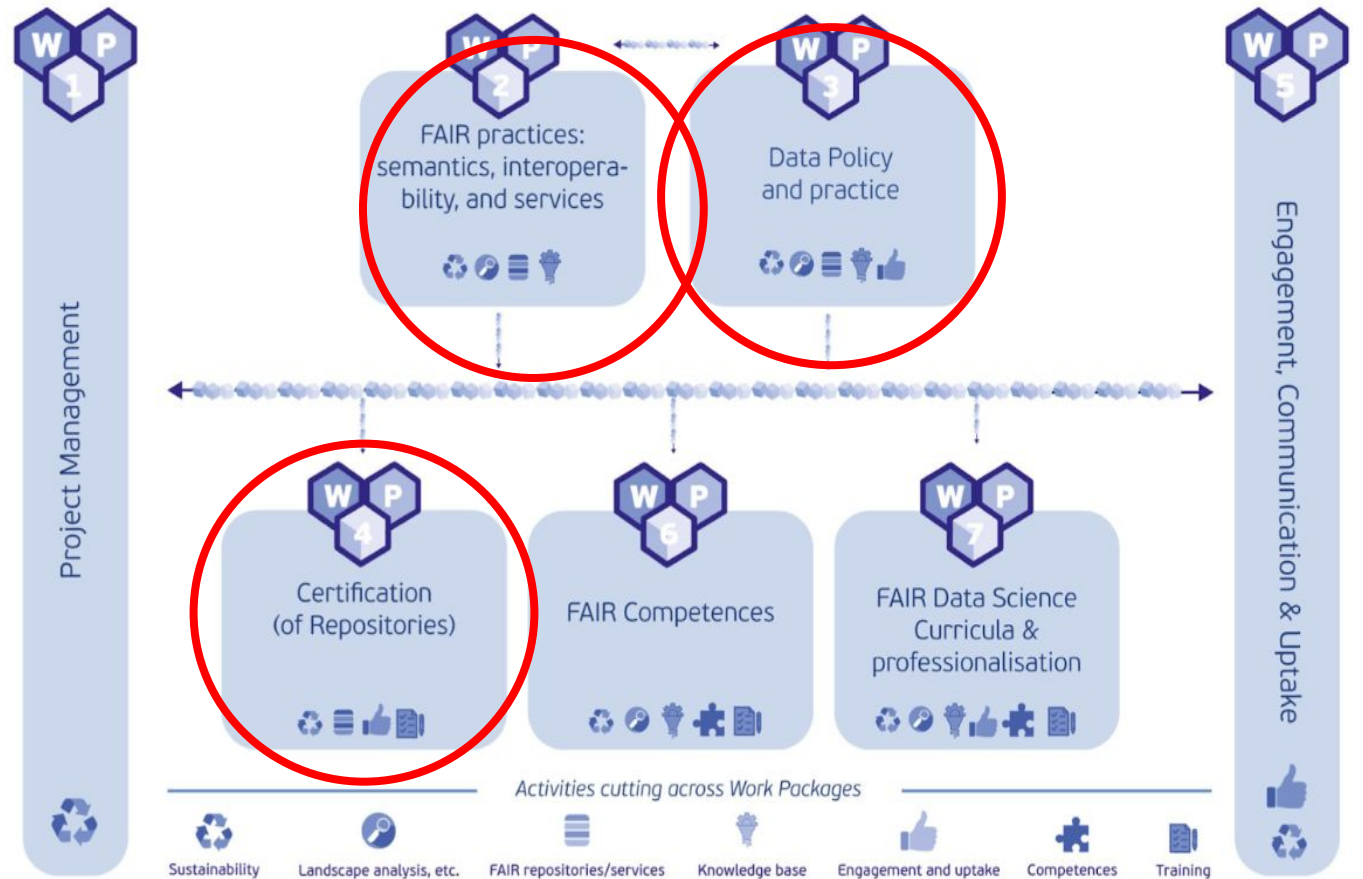

FAIRsFAIR:

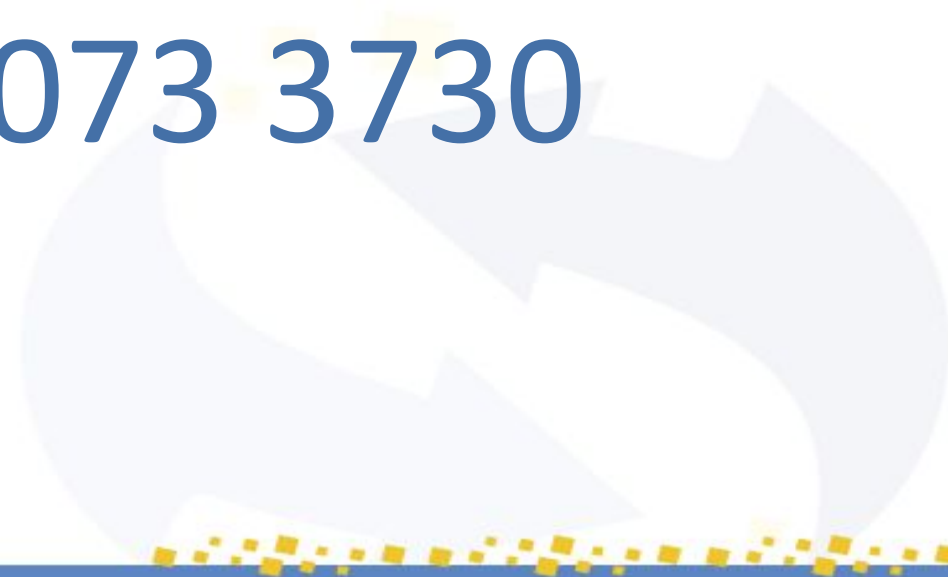
- H2020 funded project
